## Forward -

The Mount Vernon Community Trust exists to receive gifts, to invest them for safety and income and to make distributions to assist public, educational, charitable, or benevolent enterprises. It has been 26 years since it was organized on December 18, 1944. The within annual report shows the activities of the Trust during the year 1970.

Fourteen gifts from individuals, estates and corporations were received totaling \$87,818.00. Income from interest, dividends and profits on securities sold amounted to \$48,891.57.

Disbursements made from principal, income and capital gains in accordance with wishes of donors amounted to \$11,620.15 and disbursements from unrestricted funds as authorized by the Distribution Committee amounted to \$41,110.09 making a grand total of \$52,730.24. Details are included on the following pages.

New gifts are always needed and appreciated in order for the Trust to grow and render greater service. Outright gifts may be made during lifetime direct to the Trustee, unrestricted as to their use or restricted to favorite charities as donors choose. Forms for Bequest under a Will are shown on Page 16 of this report. Attorneys can also be helpful in this connection in preparing Wills. Just let them know that you wish to leave a bequest to the Mount Vernon Community Trust.

Members of the Distribution Committee and the Trustee bank welcome any questions you may have and assure careful attention to gifts during lifetime or bequests under Wills.



#### What it is . . . .

It is a fund made up of numerous gifts placed with the Trustee at different times by individuals, families, corporations, and service groups to serve permanently the educational, charitable, health, and welfare needs of the community.

#### How it works . . . .

These gifts are in the keeping of the Trustee Bank, (The First-Knox National Bank), which invests them for safety of principal and income and certifies quarterly to the Distribution Committee the amount available for distribution as directed by the donors. In the absence of such direction, the amounts available are disbursed at the discretion of the Committee in accordance with the purpose of the Trust.

## Why it works . . .

Since the Cleveland Foundation was established in 1914, many such charitable trusts have proven their value in communities throughout the country. The plan is attractive to donors since gifts of property, such as stocks and bonds, are accepted at full market value on date of transfer free of any capital gains or federal income taxes. The plan is flexible so that a donor can be certain his fund will be used effectively, even though conditions change. If a cause or purpose selected by the donor becomes obsolete, ceases to exist, merges with others, or no longer requires financial aid, the fund is then used for the support of activities in a field similiar to the one mentioned by the donor.

# Who it works for . . . .

It works for the donor by safe-guarding the principal and disbursing the income of this gift long after his decease and by winning for him a certain immortality in the memory of friends, neighbors, and specific beneficiaries.

It works for the people of the community, all of whom are benefited by gifts for civic improvements.

Gifts can be channeled through the Trust to educational, charitable, and benevolent organizations not only throughout the United States but anywhere in the world.
