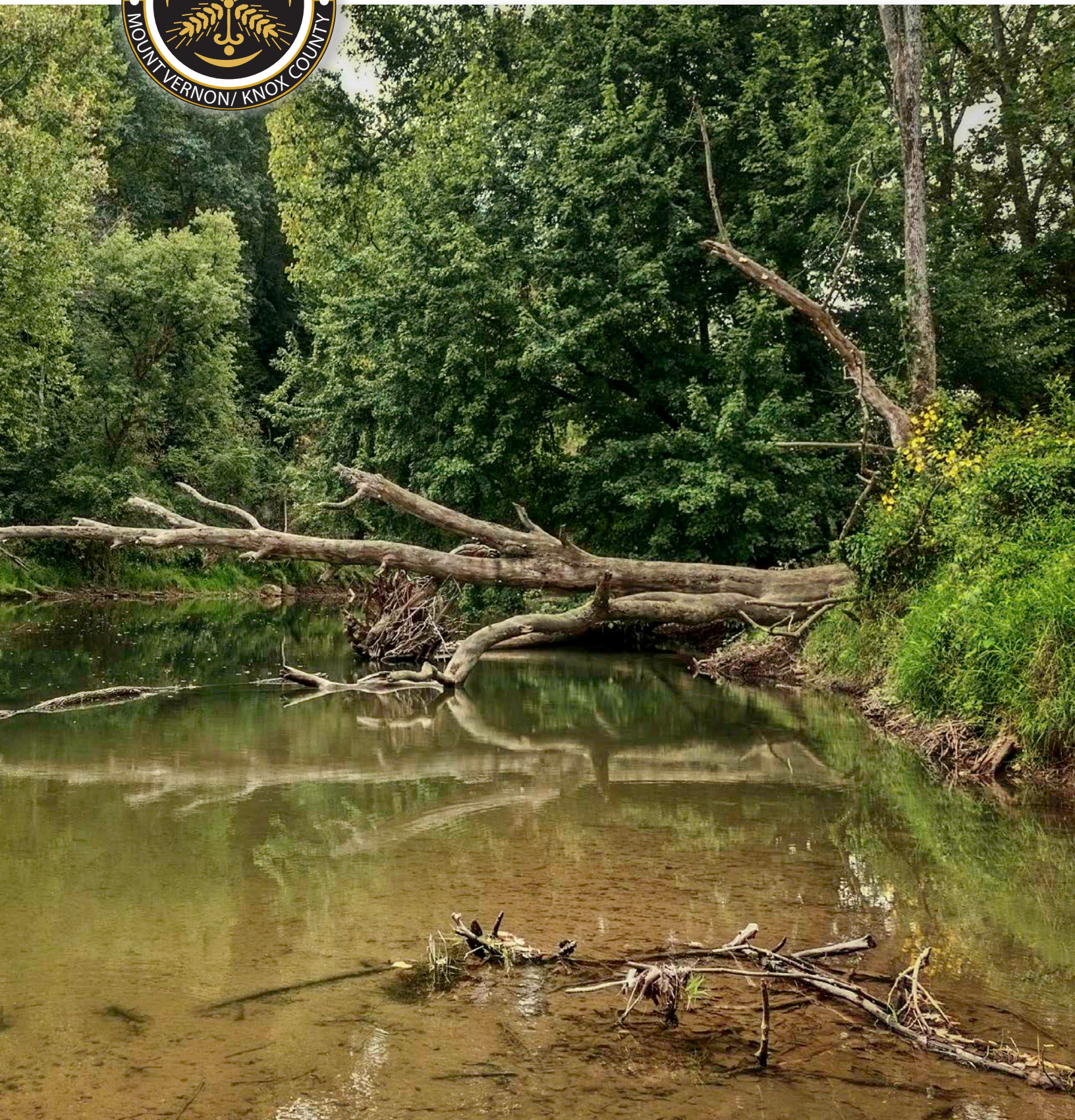

Community philanthropy: It takes more than money

We are inclined to begin our review of the 2016 Community Foundation year not with an accounting of the excellent financial results we experienced (see page 6), but by celebrating the contributions of human resources that often are slighted in a conversation about community philanthropy.

A case in point – though we hesitate to single out one of many who contribute time and talent (and usually their dollars) to charitable causes – is Mount Vernon resident Terry Walter.

The Community Foundation was introduced to Terry during a 2015 inspection tour of Mount Vernon's West Side Elementary School. The structure had been slipping into a state of disrepair ever since its student population (and that of Elmwood Elementary on the city's south side) relocated to the new Twin Oak Elementary School on Martinsburg Road in 2005.

While Elmwood School had been well-maintained as the new home of Mount Vernon Schools' administrative offices, the West Side building was vacant for a while, and was eventually offered to the Knox County Education Service Center as the site for its Knox Learning Center, an alternative education setting operated by the Center for Knox County students whose inability to thrive in traditional classrooms – for a multitude of reasons – threatens their success in school.

Through the years West Side had become a bleak educational setting by anyone's standards. But unfortunately tuition subsidies from the home school districts of Learning Center students are scarcely sufficient to cover the program's operating expenses, let alone pay for major building repairs and renovations.

During the fall of 2014, KCESC Superintendent Timm Mackley began to contemplate other strategies to address the worsening physical condition of the Learning Center,

home to a student body that fluctuates between 75 and 100.

Might they be able to tap into the philanthropic resources of Knox County to – at a minimum – seal leaking roofs and porous masonry, repair crumbling plaster walls, remove threadbare and unsanitary classroom carpeting, refinish damaged hardwood flooring, and perhaps upgrade substandard classroom lighting?

Terry Walter, a retired Anchor-Hocking Glass executive and local entrepreneur, was part of the delegation Mackley walked through West Side School one autumn morning in 2014, as was I, representing the Community

Foundation, Jan Reynolds of the Ariel Foundation, Jen Odenweller and Lisa Schott,

both representing United Way, Mount Vernon School Superintendent Bill Seder, and other community activists who tend to make problems like the Learning Center's their own (notably former Community Foundation Board Chair Mark Ramser). There was general agreement by those who had observed teachers and students in their sordid classrooms that something needed to be done.

By year-end 2014, hope had emerged that financial assistance for repairs might be available from the Ariel Foundation and the Community Foundation, as well as in-kind services from Mount Vernon City Schools, and personal contributions from individuals including Mark and Denise Ramser.

What the mission lacked at that point was a project manager – a volunteer savvy in the ways of construction – willing to spend a year with contractors to complete the project on time and on budget. Terry Walter raised his hand.

Phase I renovations to essentially seal the building from the elements were undertaken at the close of the 2014-2015 school year, driven by Terry's desire to create a hospitable learning environment for students, which far surpassed his interest

in preserving a landmark Mount Vernon school building.

Phase II work, including installation of energy efficient lighting and new flooring throughout, was completed the following summer, facilitated by additional grants from the Community Foundation and the Ariel Foundation.

By the time classes resumed in late summer 2016 Terry had seen to the completion of all or most of the critical tasks, and had recruited the Chamber of Commerce Leadership Knox Class and the Knox County Health Department to contribute an outdoor play space to the project for good measure.

Reflecting on the Learning Center's two-year journey with local philanthropic organizations and individuals, Timm Mackley said, "Adults have a responsibility to take care of kids, and Terry Walter was instrumental in bringing together a coalition of community members who took that responsibility seriously. The students and staff of the Learning Center are grateful West Side Elementary School is once again a place of encouragement, safety, and hope for many Knox County students."

A satisfying resolution of a difficult problem for the Knox County Learning Center for sure; but that's only half the story of Terry's recent collaboration with the Community Foundation and others in service of Knox County youth.

As the Learning Center renovation reached its midpoint in the fall of 2015, Terry and (once again)

Mark Ramser began exploring the possibility of relocating a 15 year-old Mount Vernon youth center known as The Escape Zone from its cramped and dank quarters on South Main Street to the vacant Armory on Mansfield Avenue, recently acquired by Ramser with such a charitable purpose in mind.

Other non-profit organizations had explored comprehensive renovation of the Armory, but had walked away due to prohibitive cost projections. Terry, on the other hand, adopted a more measured approach to the opportunity: take advantage of the Armory's massive square footage, while attempting only those renovations necessary to create a safe, code-compliant space, suitable for year-around youth activity.

Terry's resourcefulness, and his gift for recruiting like-minded (and skilled) volunteers, was once again poised to yield great dividends for the youth of Knox County.

The Community Foundation board of directors at its February 2016 meeting listened carefully to Terry's Armory pitch, and responded with its largest single project commitment of the year. Other community organizations followed suit with their own grants, enabling work on the Armory to commence immediately and be completed in time for a February 2017 grand reopening of The Escape Zone. Since then some 75-80 students, ages 10 to 18, have been engaged

in myriad weekend activities under the guidance of adult mentors. (Visit *The Escape Zone's Facebook page* to learn more about opportunities available for area youth, as well as for adult volunteers.)

During the course of these two major projects, we had occasion to ask Terry, who chairs The Escape Zone Board and is on-site several days a week, what motivates him to volunteer so much time to youth-focused activities. Certainly his Christian faith is a major driver in this mission; but it's also clear that a career immersed in the human resources aspects of business had taught him the importance of developing personal qualities and strengthening core values. Terry also possesses a keen understanding of the fact a community suffers when its youngest citizens lack self esteem and fail to take full advantage of educational opportunities.

How often we have heard visitors marvel at the magnitude of charitable investment evident in Knox County; and, indeed, we are blessed beyond measure by that level of generosity. But, as you peruse this annual report of the Foundation's 72nd year of operation, we hope you will also appreciate fully the contributions of time and talent that are essential components of community philanthropy.

There's no better example than Terry Walter.

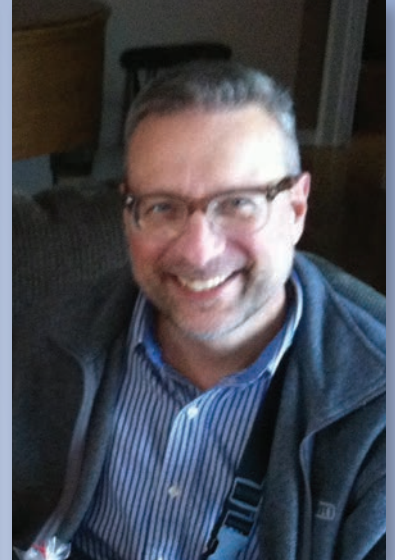

The Community Foundation of Mount Vernon & Knox County enjoyed tremendous growth in 2016. This was due to the sustained generosity of its donors as well and a recovering investment market that generated positive gains in excess of 10 percent. Revenues exceeded \$10 million and helped push the accumulated assets of the Foundation and its associated organizations to nearly \$62 million, almost \$8 million more than Foundation assets in 2015. Of the total contributions in excess of \$5.3 million this year, more than \$2.6 million were received from non-profit organizations

seeking increased investment returns and broader diversification, not typically available to individual investors. Estate giving from individuals accounted for more than \$1 million, and continues to be the largest historical source both for new funds and Foundation assets.

Nearly \$3 million was distributed in grants to qualifying organizations and students during 2016, and almost \$630,000 was awarded through the Community Foundation's competitive grant process. Scholarships awarded to local students jumped to nearly \$850,000,

which represents an increase of almost \$100,000 from the prior year. The Foundation made a sustained effort to grow its scholarship program and assist local youth in realizing their educational goals. Our donor-advised funds, through recommendations from our donors, continue to support local organizations, including significant gifts in 2016 to Mount Vernon Nazarene University and Ariel-Foundation Park.

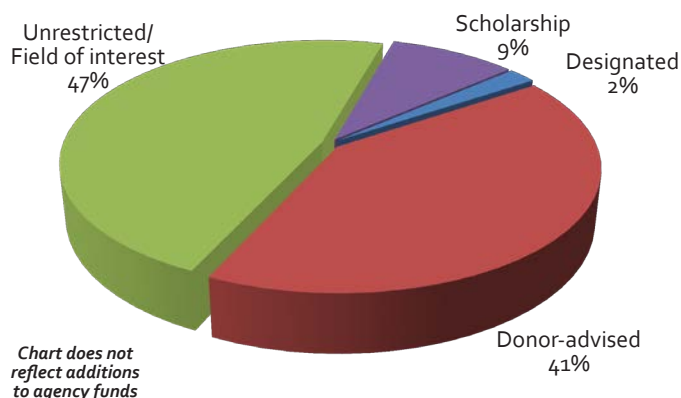
After a relatively flat 2015, the investment environment substantially improved for the nation, and for the Foundation, as evidenced by our 2016 total return of 9.9 percent. With expert guidance from our investment advisors and investment committee the Foundation continues to balance investment return and risk. We accomplish this by diversifying our portfolio with equity holdings such as common stocks, and debt holdings including corporate and government bonds. Under the current investment portfolio weighting of 70% equity and 30% debt, the Foundation balances principal preservation with capital growth.



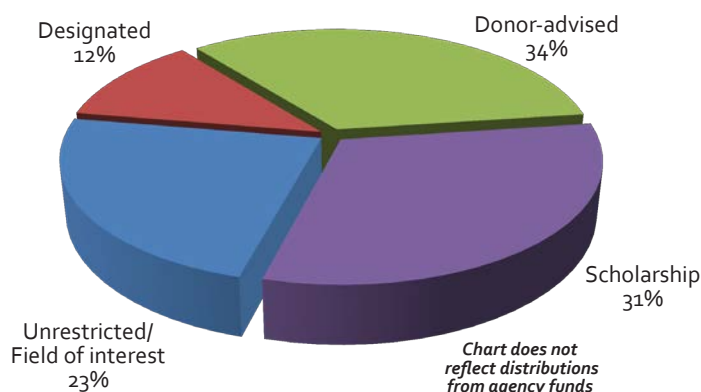

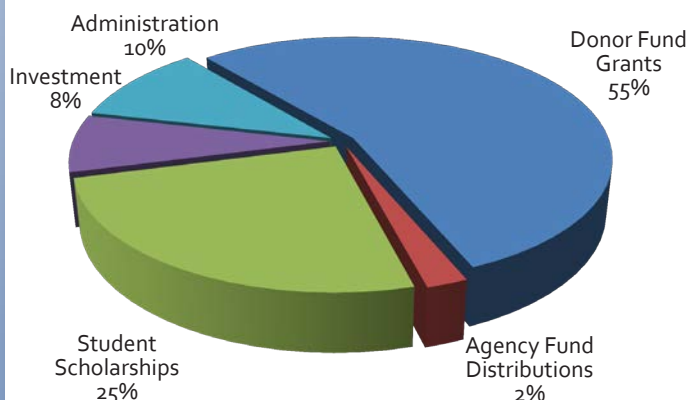
2016 Donor contributions by fund type

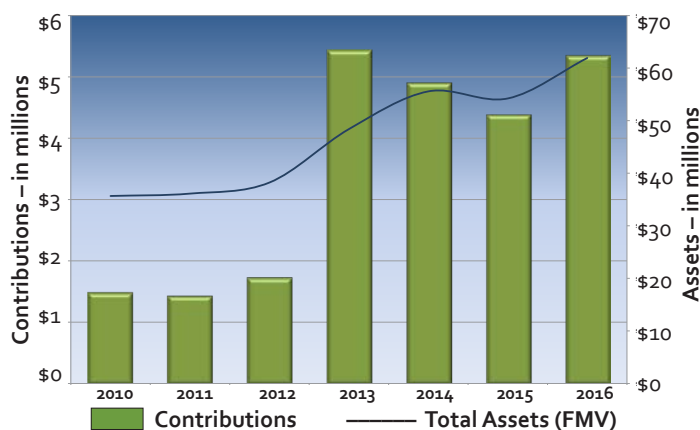


Chart I - Historical contribution trend

Since 2013, the Foundation has enjoyed tremendous public support with contributions exceeding \$4 million annually during this period. Gifts received in 2016 were within \$100,000 of the record contribution amount received in 2013. Since the end of 2012, the Foundation has grown from approximately \$36 million in assets to nearly \$60 million by the end of 2016 due to the increased donor and organization support.

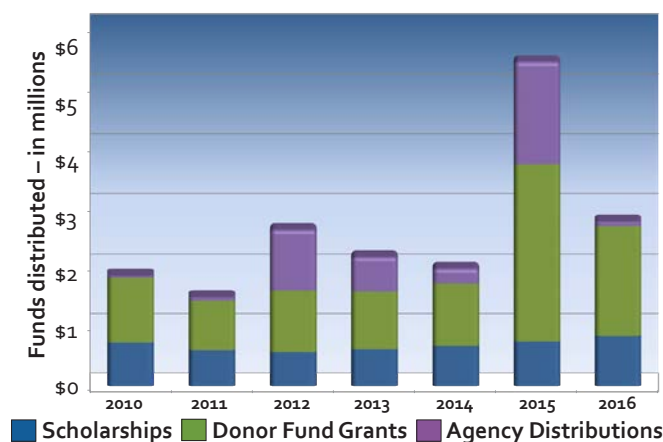


Chart II - Charitable distributions by type

The Foundation has three primary types of distributions: student scholarships; agency fund distributions requested by the respective non-profit organization; and charitable grants from advised, designated, unrestricted and field of interest funds. The 2016 fiscal year shows a return to a more historical level of grant-making after a historic 2015 grant year. Total grant distributions for the Foundation's competitive grant process and scholarships remain steady from year to year but donor advised requests and agency fund distributions can fluctuate greatly.

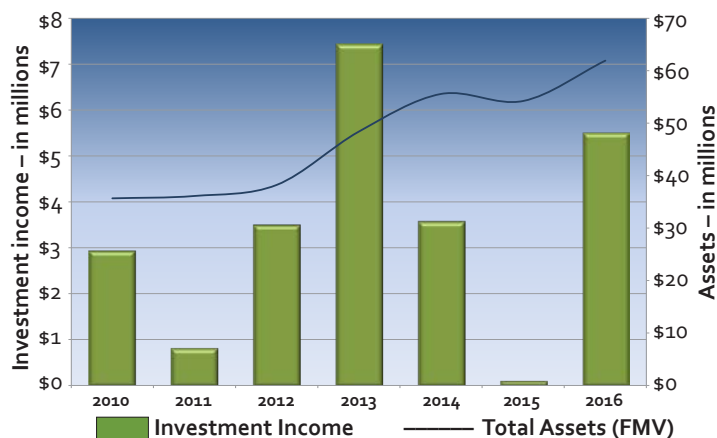


Chart III - Historical investments trend

During the most recent five-year period, assets held by the Foundation have benefitted from market growth averaging nearly nine percent, after investment fees. However, this chart indicates on a short-term basis the volatility of the investment market. The Foundation sets its spending policy to account for these fluctuations and to allow for a less volatile grant distribution process. This ensures more consistent cash flow to the organizations and students we support.

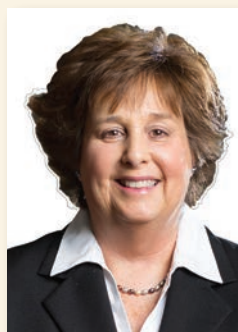
